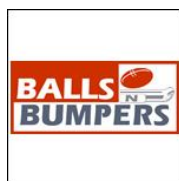

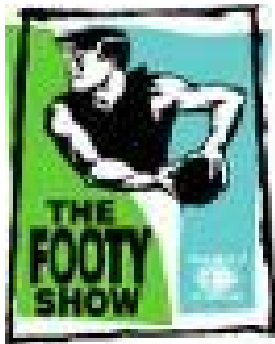
JW – You played one Senior game back in 1998 against Burnie at West Park – what are some of your great memories?
