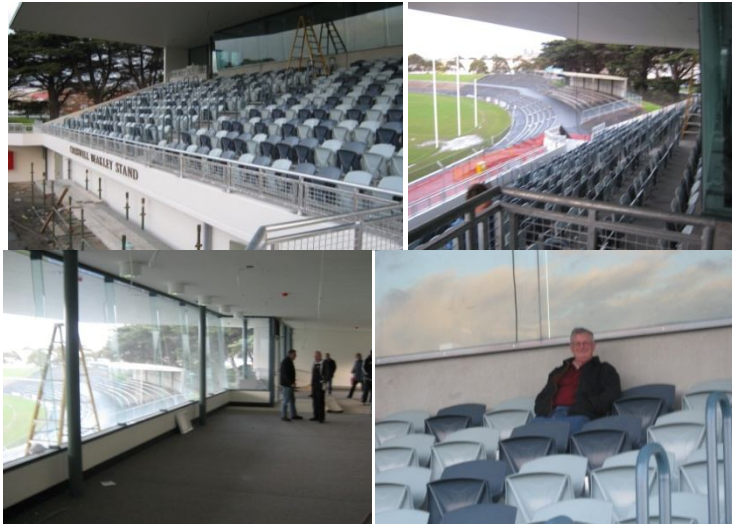




Cresswell / Beakley Stand – Not far away from completion...

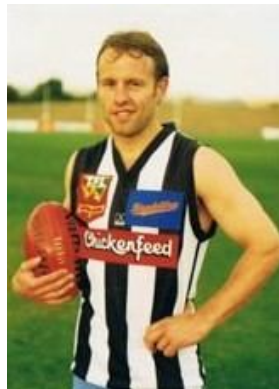

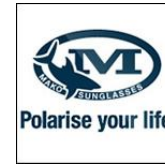
